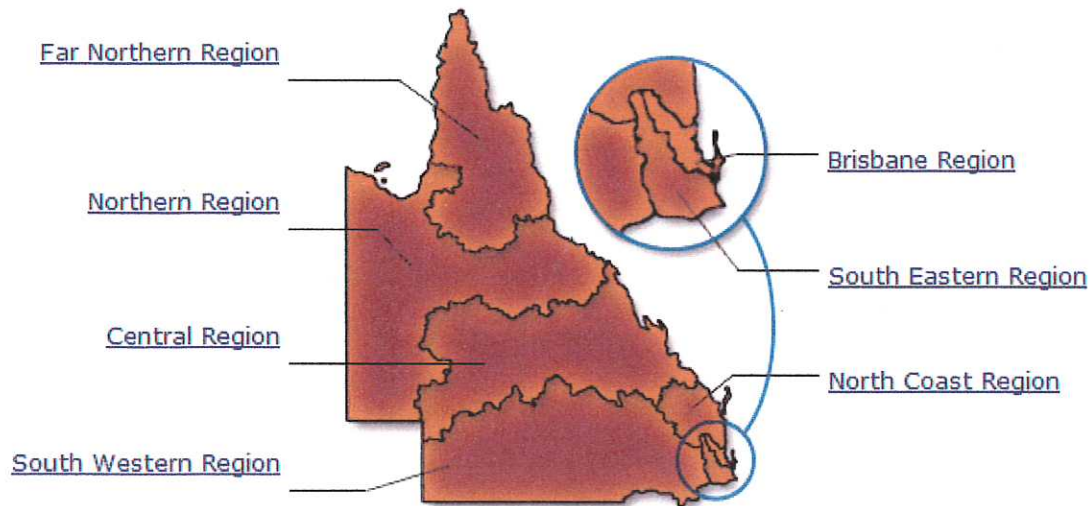

IZONE BRIGADE

Brigade Area consists of a significant amount of medium and high bushfire prone areas and consists of a considerable rural residential development or township. The brigade will generally have three or more appliances, a station, and a minimum membership of 24 volunteers. The brigade will generally receive levy funding from local government.

PRIMARY PRODUCER BRIGADE

Land use is based on primary production and the brigade area does not contain a settlement or village or any rural residential areas. Brigade members are generally owner occupiers of properties within the brigade area. The brigade has no appliances, no station, does not receive levy funding and relies mainly on property based equipment for firefighting purposes.

RURAL BRIGADE

The brigade area contains a significant number of rural producing properties and may contain small rural residential developments. The brigade may have or share an appliance and may have a fire station or shed. They may receive funding from local government.

SPECIAL SERVICE DELIVERY BRIGADE

These brigades provide a specific service to meet a community need (e.g. resorts, mines) through an agreed service delivery model and do not fit the characteristics of the other brigade types.

VILLAGE BRIGADE

The brigade may have a small amount of medium or high bushfire prone areas and the surrounding areas will be principally rural properties or interspersed with rural residential. The area contains a village of twenty or more buildings. The brigade may have two appliances, a fire station and may receive funding from local government.
